Pocket (fabric) to clip into binder tc (optional)  
No. 2 pencils or mechanical pencils with extra lead  
6" Ruler transparent or translucent  
Protractor transparent or translucent (Geometry students only)  
Compass - Geometry students only  
one that tightens by using a METAL screw in the middle  
*You may have to get this kind of compass at an office supply type of store  
Don't get the plastic type as they break VERY easily.*  
**\*Buy a TI83 OR purchase a dozen batteries for classromm TI-83 use.**  
°Projects and reports will require additional supplies as needed.
