College Credit Options

- **CT² Statewide Articulation Agreements = 2 college credits**
- AND {
 - Earn a “C” or better in the Ground transportation Maintenance course (177000)
 - Pass the ASE test: Maintenance and Light Repair **OR** Automotive Service and Technology
 - Submit proper paper work
 - Credits accepted at all state schools in Ohio **IF** an automotive degree is offered

- **Tech Prep @ Tri-C = 3 college credits**
 - Earn a 2.75 CTEGPA
 - Earn a 2.0 CGPA (9-12)
 - Submit proper paper work
 - Pass the End of Course offered @ TRI-C for their course Auto 1450 Auto Braking Systems

- **Tech Prep @ University of Akron = Up to 30 college credits**
 - Based on passing of the 10 ASE tests
 - Individual review of performance by the UA staff
 - Submit proper paper work

- **Tech Prep @ Kent State University= Up to 30 college credits**
 - Based on passing of the 10 ASE tests
 - Individual review of performance by the Kent State Staff
 - Submit proper paper work

- **Agreement/University of Northwestern Ohio= 12 college credits**
 - Submit proper paper work

- **Tech Prep @ Hocking College= 17 college credits**
 - Submit proper paper work

NOTE: The granting of college credits is time sensitive. For optimal results, complete all necessary paper work before graduation
