From I-90 Westbound	From I-90 Eastbound
Exit 165B toward W.140 St/Bunts Rd (0.1 mi)	Exit 165 to Warren Rd/Bunts Rd/W. 140 St (0.2 mi)
Turn right (north) onto W.140 St. (0.1 mi)	Merge on South Marginal Dr (0.6 mi)
Continue onto Bunts Rd. (0.6 mi)	Turn left (north) onto W 140 St. (0.1 mi)
Turn left into LHS parking lot after baseball field.	Continue onto Bunts Rd. (0.6 mi)
Proceed west to loading dock doors #21 and 23.	Turn left into LHS parking lot after baseball field.
	Proceed west to loading dock doors #21 and 23.
Please proceed slowly on campus, and observe posted Fire Lane requirements.	

- Bus Parking** Located within 100’ of the backstage area. There is NO shore power available.
- Truck Parking** In loading area – providing fire lanes are maintained. Overflow parking is across the street from the theater on Franklin Boulevard.
- Load-in*** Ramp off truck, to ground level, ramp into building, onto freight elevator, then onto stage. Load-in: Door# 21 is 9’6” high by 11’ wide; Door# 23 is 9’6” high by 9’5” wide. Door 23 has a hydraulic loading platform.
- Freight Elevator** 7’ high x 9’ deep x 11’ wide – 7,000 pound capacity. Located stage right. There is a 4’ height difference from the load-in elevation onto stage elevation.
- House Lights** House lights are controlled from stage left, tech area front-of-house and control booth.
- Power** 400 amp; 3 Phase, 4W 120/208V-located upstage left
 300 amp; 1 Phase, 3W 120/240V-located up stage left
- Dressing Rooms** Two dressing rooms with restrooms are accessible from stage right and left. Showers are available in the Physical Education wing, rooms E174 and E175. Passenger elevator available from stage level to green room area.
- Production Office** Downstairs area under stage has Green Room with 2 phone lines. Additional area is next to Catering with 3 phone lines. Internet hard-wire lines are available in either area, upon advance request.
- Internet Connection** Wi-Fi available upon request.
- Follow Spots** 2 HM1 500. Clear-com in house.
- Barricade** Orchestra pit is normally seated.
- Sound Level Limits** None. Note that you cannot sound check until after 3 PM when school is in session.

Stagehands	Non-union
House Fire Curtain	Please note – Nothing may obstruct the fire curtain (7 feet from the downstage edge). You may place monitors or mike stands upstage or downstage of the curtain, but <i>nothing</i> may block the curtain.
Front of House Position	45 feet from the downstage edge
Snake runs	Must go beneath seating area requiring 75' from front-of-stage to front-of-house.
Stage	Typical proscenium; permanent fixed structure 60' wide x 38' deep by 4' high. Curtain opens to 55.'
Apron Depth	5'7"
Stage Left Wing	19'4"
Stage Right Wing	9'8"
Proscenium Opening	24' High
Soft Goods	Main curtain and valance are dead hung. Four travelers with borders are counterweighted. White cyclorama is counterweighted.

Rigging

Fly lighting and stack sound are permitted

Seven scenery battens, counterweighted
 Five house electric battens, counterweighted
 There are two points over the pit, approximately 8' downstage.

The beams are spaced as follows:
 There are 3 beams stage left. They are 7', 19' and 31' off center.
 There are 3 beams stage right. They are 6', 19' and 31' off center.

The thimble from the rigging steel will not fit over the beam, thus the need for two-ton beam clamps *house does not supply*. There is no place to hang audio without obstructing the fire curtain.

Other

*Please note: Due to the fact that the theater is located on a campus, load-in must accommodate the movement of students through the hallways between 8am-3:15pm. This means that every 40 minutes, load-in (i.e. moving cases through the hallways) must cease for a span of six minutes while students change classes. This DOES NOT affect any work in the theater, however, an LPD uniformed officer must be onsite if load-in occurs during the school day.

4. Smoke pocket to upstage wall 38'8"
5. Stage floor to grid (I-beam) 37'8"
6. Wing right 9'8"
7. Wing left 19'4"
8. Four sets of borders and travelers: (from proscenium wall)
 - 6'6"
 - 13'0"
 - 20'0"
 - 26'6"
9. Five electrics: (from proscenium wall)
 - 3'6"
 - 5'0"
 - 14'6"
 - 22'0"
 - 32'0"
10. Cyclorama hung at: (from proscenium wall) 33'6"
11. Nine available scenery battens: (from proscenium wall)
 - 8'6"
 - 10'6"
 - 16'0"
 - 18'0"
 - 23'6"
 - 24'6"
 - 29'6"
 - 30'6"
