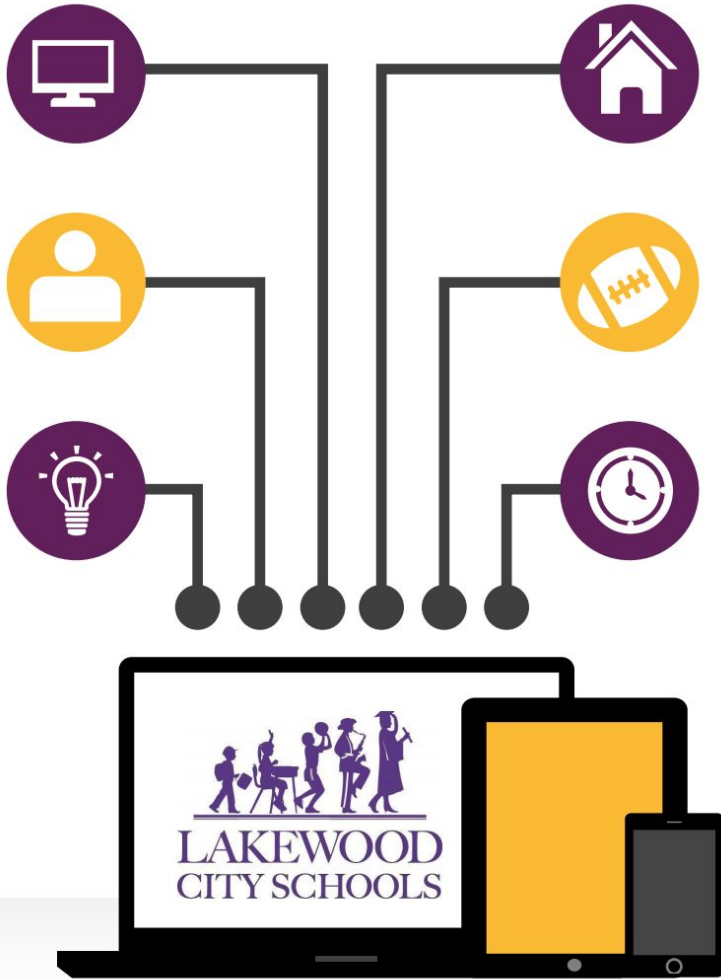


# 2020-2021 Middle School Orientation

# Attendance

## **School attendance is mandatory for students K-12.**

If your child is ill and cannot participate in instruction, please call the school building as you have done in the past to report an absence at 529-4311.

During remote learning, students will be required to log in daily for instruction and for an attendance check at 9:00 am.

It is expected that students will participate and complete assignments during remote learning, however this will be reflected in their grade/progress in class, not as an attendance marker.

1	9:00 - 9:35		<b>Attendance will be taken Monday thru Friday during 1st period. If you are not logged in on time, you will be marked absent.</b>  <b>Monday and Wednesday:</b> Live face-to-face Zoom lessons  <b>Tuesday and Thursday:</b> Log in for attendance to your 1st period at 9:00 am. Then you will have time to work on practice activities/assignments. On these days, teachers will be available via Zoom during your class periods for any needed support. Teachers may also schedule individual or small group Zoom lessons with students during your assigned class period.  <b>Friday:</b> Log in for attendance to your 1st period at 9:00 am and your weekly Social-Emotional Activity. You will not have new learning during this day. Friday will focus on students having time to catch up on activities from the week. Teachers may schedule individual or small group interventions on this day.

# Responsibilities for Students

- Map out a daily/weekly plan to keep up on your responsibilities in order to complete assigned work by the due date
- Actively participate in remote learning experiences, meet educational expectations, and communicate if not possible
- Ask clarifying questions when help is needed
- Respond to instructional feedback provided by teacher(s)
- Respect yourself, your teachers and your peers while appropriately using technology.

# Zoom Etiquette: Be Respectful



- Mute your microphone when you are not talking.
- All comments in the chat must be respectful, positive, and productive.
- All norms apply to break out rooms.
- The teacher begins the meeting, sets the expectations and ends the meeting.

# Zoom Etiquette: Be Responsible



- Be prepared to begin on time.
  - If late, be aware that the meeting is already in progress.
  - Avoid interrupting.
- Use the chat bar for questions, not conversations.
- Put away materials that are not relevant, including your phone.
- While highly encouraged, video is optional.



# Zoom Etiquette: Be Safe

- Recording or taking pictures is not allowed without permission first.
- Dress appropriately with nothing personal or distracting in your background.
- Enter the meeting with your first and last name displayed.

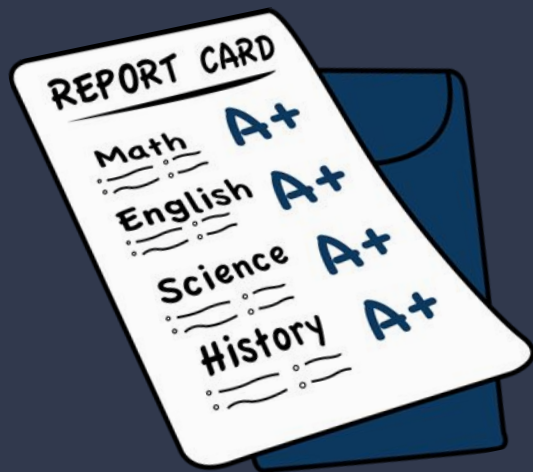
# Responsibilities for Parents

- Talk to student(s) about their learning and progress routinely and set sensible time limits for technology use
- Reach out to a teacher for support and access to additional resources
- Communicate concerns to staff
- Contact principal with WiFi and technology needs
- Ensure your student is logging on and actively engaged in learning everyday.
- Provide meaningful feedback to the District
- Designate a space for remote learning, help students to establish and follow daily routines by reviewing their learning plans with them

# Responsibilities for Staff

- Build and maintain relationships with students
- Communicate clear learning plans to students and families
- Provide meaningful instruction on new content/skills and opportunities for practice
- Provide timely instructional feedback on student work and overall progress
- Identify and refer students/families needing additional support
- Utilize help sessions
