

Dear Parents/Guardians:

Per the Ohio Department of Health, all students entering the 12th grade during the 2017-2018 school year are required to have two (2) doses of Meningococcal (MCV4) vaccine. If your child received a dose of the MCV4 vaccine after their 16th birthday, only one dose of the vaccine is required.

If your child has received the required vaccination(s), please provide a current immunization record to the Health Center at Lakewood High School by September 8, 2017. If your child needs to be vaccinated, immunizations may be obtained through your child's health care provider, the Cuyahoga County Board of Health (216-201-2041) or at the Cleveland Clinic Children's Hospital School-Based Health Clinic (SBHC) at Lakewood High School.

The SBHC will be holding an immunization clinic at LHS on Thursday, May 18, 2017 from 8:00 AM – 3:00 PM to assist students obtain required vaccinations with minimal interruption to classroom instruction. If you are interested in having your child vaccinated at the SBHC at LHS, please complete the enrollment packet (link below) and return it to the Health Center at Lakewood High School by 5/12/2017.
